elevators capable of transporting the 7series cars to all six floors.

Several innovative techniques were utilized during construction including removing 1/3 of the 6th floor to provide a 2-storey delivery area, which boasts the Toronto downtown skyline as a backdrop.

Given the severe winter, the diligent management and collective efforts of the owner, designers and trade contractors resulted in the project being completed on time and on budget for BMW's first vertical showroom in North America.
